17. Pinot Grigio Rosé, Provincia di Pavia IGT, Ca'Solare (Italy) 2007 £14.50

A copper pink rosé from Northern Italy's Pavia region with gently fragrant summer fruits on the nose and delicate strawberry fruit on the palate. Fruitily off-dry.

Champagnes

18. Champagne J-P Robert, Brut £31.50

From mostly Pinot Noir with the balance Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay, this full-flavoured, rich champagne with complex aromas and nutty, biscuity flavour sees 3 years ageing before disgorgement. From a family estate in the Aube.

19. Pol Roger Brut Réserve White Foil £41.50

From a family-owned firm established over 150 years ago with 175 acres of prime vineyards around Epernay. An elegant champagne with aromas of brioche. Dry with apples and minerals, finesse and poise on the palate.

20. Strawberry Hill Classic Sparkling £19.75

A locally produced wine from Strawberry Hill Vineyard in Newant, Gloucestershire. Light, crisp, and well balanced, this sparkling wine is ideal for any occasion.

White Wines

- Vicuña Semillon/Sauvignon, Central Valley (Chile) 2007** £12.95
A deliciously crisp, classic combination from the sunny Central Valley of Chile, wedged between the mountains and the sea. An aromatic and flavour-filled white for easy drinking.

- Franschhoek Cellar Chardonnay, Franschhoek (South Africa) 2007** £13.75
A complete, lightly oaked Chardonnay coming from the beautiful Franschhoek Valley. Lychee and melon flavours are offset by hints of butterscotch, making this a full, satisfying white.

- Cà Solare Pinot Grigio, Provincia di Pavia IGT (Italy) 2007** £14.50
With a crisp, dry, lightly floral character and a subtle honeyed note on the finish, this is a good example of Pinot Grigio, a white that has quickly become one of the most popular wines in Britain.

- Muscadet Sèvre-et-Maine Sur Lie, Domaine Fief de la Brie (France) 2006** £15.50
An attractive white with crisp acidity that is ideal with seafood. The wine is aged on its lees, or sediment, for six months to impart more body to the wine.

- Wide River Viognier, Robertson (South Africa) 2007** £15.95
Long aromatic nose of apricot, peaches and lemon with orange peel on the palate, which has good weight and freshness. An excellent example of this very popular grape variety.
- House of Certain Views Unwooded Chardonnay, Hunter Valley, (Australia) 2006** £17.50
This flavoursome white is a recent addition from Andrew and Lisa Margan from their estate in the Hunter Valley. Overflowing with citrus and melon and not a hint of oak in sight.
- Cousiño-Macul Doña Isidora Riesling, Maipo Valley (Chile) 2006** £19.75
A dry Riesling with a nose of flowers and honey, before a weighty palate of ripe fruit flavours, beautifully balanced.
- Churton Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough (New Zealand) 2007** £22.50
A delicious grassy, nettly, gooseberry flavoured Sauvignon full of ripe passion fruit and mango flavours with a mineral finish. This wine is extremely well balanced with fine mouth watering acidity and a lovely lingering finish.

Red Wines

- Vicuña Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot, Central Valley (Chile) 2007** £12.95
Soft and full, with juicy red and black fruits in this classic combination of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. A very easy style with an element of ripe Claret about it.

- Alto Pampas Pinot Noir, Mendoza (Argentina) 2007** £13.75
The grapes are grown in higher altitude vineyards to keep freshness, so the wine shows fine, very pure New World Pinot fruit with typical leafy, raspberry flavours and soft, ripe tannins.

- Wide River Shiraz, Robertson (South Africa) 2006** £14.50
Easy going, soft red with plenty of spicy, peppery fruit, good berried flavours and length. Shiraz is proving to be a very popular and successful grape variety in South Africa.

- Angel's Flight Merlot, California (USA) 2005** £15.50
This is classic Merlot - full of plum jam fruit with succulence and a hint of spice. This red is ripe and robust, full in the mouth with charming, easy drinking fruit.

- Marius Reserva, Almansa, Bodegas Piqueras (Spain) 2004** £16.50
Almansa lies just 100kms inland from Valencia where the perfect climate provides ideal growing conditions. Mainly Tempranillo with 18 months in American oak, fully mature with spicy fruit on the nose and a rich, full palate.
- House of Certain Views Shiraz, Orange, Margan Wines 2005** £18.50
We can't be certain what views Andrew Margan gets from his house; hopefully they're as stunning as this wine. Black berry fruit meets smoky bacon and wait for those soft, silky tannins to kick in. Pure velvet and a great view!
- Côte de Brouilly, Les Volcaniques, J Charlet (France) 2006** £19.95
From the slopes of the distinctive, round hill of Brouilly comes this fruity Beaujolais.
- Château de Sours, Bordeaux (France) 2002** £22.50
This is a deliciously soft and fruity wine that has lovely cassis and wild berry flavours, very juicy and elegant with great length.
